

Brays C2 CPE Course with exam practice

This Cambridge tests course is to match CEFR level C2. There are 8 units to this course, each with 4 syllabus items + extensive CPE exam (Cambridge Proficiency Exam) practice, web projects and news items. Each syllabus item has three syllabus components: Grammar Focus, Topic Focus and a 'Can do' statement.

Course length = **100 hours** approximately.

UNIT 1

Society: ethics and the law (7 Cambridge Tests items)

2 listening activities, **2** listening activities and **1** vocabulary activity providing practice of the kind of language we use to talk about ethical behaviour and the law. **2** grammar reference units also provide practice of inversion structures.

Society: crime (7 items)

3 language exercises, **2** vocabulary activities, **1** listening activity and **1** game offering practice in the kind of language we use to talk about crime and criminals. They also provides practice of phrasal verbs.

Society: discipline (5 items)

1 language exercise, **1** listening activity and **3** CPE exam papers giving practice in the kind of language we use to talk about discipline. They also provide practice of various language structures.

Society: public life and social contact (5 Cambridge Tests items)

3 language exercises that give provides practice in the kind of language we use to talk about public life and social contact. **2** grammar items that offer practice of relative clauses.

UNIT 2

Progress: development (7 Cambridge Tests items)

4 Cambridge CPE exam papers, **1** IELTS test reading passage, **1** news item and **1** grammar task providing practice in the kind of language we use to talk about progress and development. There is also practice of writing an article.
