

## **BRAYS LISTENING LIBRARY – ENGLISH LISTENING SKILLS COURSE – A1, A2 LEVELS**

Listening is by far the most important skill. It is **especially useful if you want to speak English.**

**The complete listening library** contains over a 1000 podcasts and videos with speakers with many different accents.

The items:

- are carefully graded from elementary to proficiency level.
- include the script and
- have a recording and playback function allowing you to compare your pronunciation with that of the native speaker.

For best results:

1. Listen to the recording.
2. Listen again and complete the exercises or task.
3. Listen whilst reading the script.
4. Record your voice.
5. Compare your pronunciation with that of the speaker.

Both listening and reading are excellent ways of acquiring a language. The listening library is probably the most complete source of listening/reading materials on the web.

This part of the course is at a basic level (CEFR A1/A2). If you complete it within the three months of your subscription you will be given the intermediate level course at no extra cost.
